

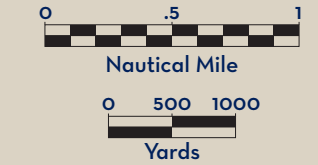
ZONE 1

Turning Basin to Five Mile Beacon

Pollution Reports
Report all spills of oil and hazardous substances to the National Response Center via 800.424.8802 (toll free), and the nearest U.S. Coast Guard facility VTS 281.464.4837, (33 CFR 153), and Texas General Land Office 800.832.8224.

Tides

The diurnal tide is about one foot. Southeasterly wind raises the water level by about one to two feet whereas Northwesterly winds reduces the water level by about one to two feet depending on the velocity of the wind.

- 40 feet/12.19 meters up to S.P. Slip
- 36 feet/10.97 meters to the Turning Basin
- 45 feet/13.72 meters Barbours Cut Channel
- 45 feet/13.72 meters Bayport Channel

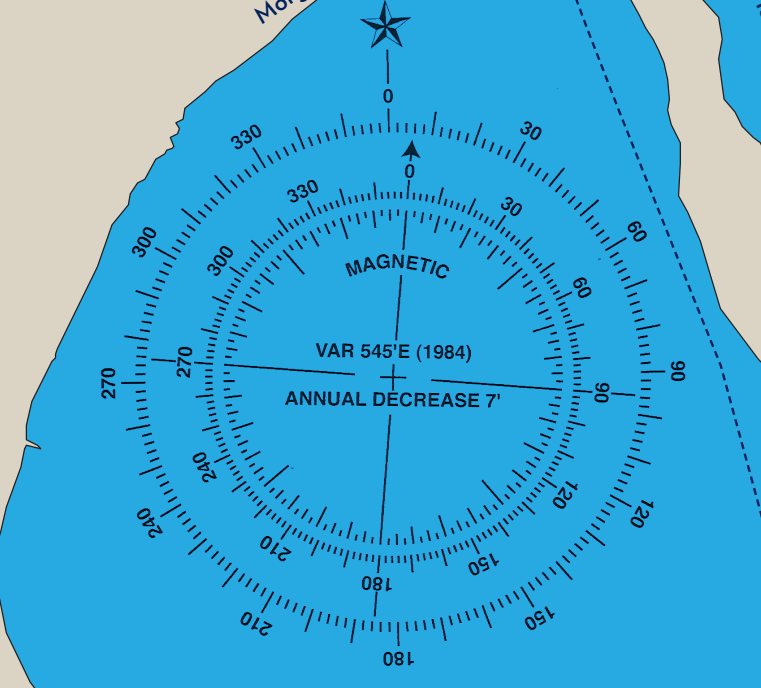
